Knowledge Points

1. Spiritual Growth and Divine Guidance

- Intimacy with God The speaker emphasizes the importance of walking intimately with God and communing with Him.

3. The simplicity and accessibility of God's peace, love, and mercy in daily life through faith and spiritual practices.

- **Peace like a river** The speaker references a scripture that describes extending peace like a river, illustrating the abundance and continuity of peace available from God.
- **Childlike faith** The speaker emphasizes the importance of having a childlike faith to enter the kingdom of heaven, suggesting simplicity and purity in one's relationship with God.

4. Spiritual empowerment through reliance on God, understanding one's identity in Christ, and the active engagement in spiritual practices like confession and walking in the light.

- Encouragement in adversity The speaker references King David encouraging himself in the Lord during times of distress, illustrating the importance of self-encouragement and reliance on God's strength.
- **God as a stronghold** The concept of God being a stronghold and refuge is emphasized, contrasting with the enemy's attempts to create strongholds through deception.
- **Identity in Christ** The speaker talks about the believer's identity being secured and hidden in Christ, which is foundational to overcoming spiritual challenges.
- The power of confession and agreement with
 God Highlighting the power of aligning one's confession with
 God's word, which acts as a spiritual strategy to combat the
 lies of the enemy.
- New creation in Christ The transformation into a new creation upon accepting Christ is discussed, emphasizing the renewal of life and dismissal of the past.
- **Role of believers as gatekeepers** Believers are described as gatekeepers who can open themselves to God and intercede for others, emphasizing spiritual responsibility.
- **The ministry of reconciliation** The speaker mentions the ministry of reconciliation given to believers, stressing the role of Christians in restoring relationships through Christ.

- **Confession and forgiveness** The assurance of forgiveness through confession is discussed, reinforcing the promise that God is faithful to forgive and cleanse from unrighteousness.
- Walking in the light Walking in the light is portrayed as living transparently and honestly before God, which ensures fellowship with Him and purification from sin.
- **The truth setting free** The liberating power of knowing and embracing the truth of God's word is highlighted as essential for spiritual freedom.

5. The significance of integrating prayer and daily actions as demonstrated by Jesus, and the foundational role of Christ in spiritual life.

- **Importance of Prayer** The speaker emphasizes the importance of prayer, specifically highlighting the practice of going into a prayer closet to communicate privately with God as taught in Matthew 6.
- Jesus' Example The speaker reflects on how Jesus might have prayed daily, using the Lord's Prayer as an example, and how his actions post-prayer demonstrated the kingdom of God.
- Integration of Prayer and Action The speaker connects the act of prayer to subsequent actions such as healing and exorcism, illustrating how spiritual practices should lead to tangible acts that affirm God's kingdom.
- Encouragement to Follow Jesus' Example Listeners are encouraged to start their day with prayer, specifically the Lord's Prayer, and to engage in fasting and scripture reading to strengthen their spiritual life.
- **Building Life on Christ** The metaphor of building a house on a rock is used to describe the foundation that Jesus provides,

emphasizing stability and security derived from a life built on Christ.

• **Technical Note on Video Feed** The speaker mentions a break to manage technical aspects of the video feed, ensuring a smoother experience for online viewers.

6. Spiritual revelation and preparation for an upcoming religious conference

- **Revelation of the river of God** The river of God is highlighted as a significant revelation received by Steve, which has been meditated upon for 25-30 years.
- Importance of personal revelations Individuals are encouraged to treasure personal revelations from God, as these can be impactful in one-on-one interactions.
- Impartation through personal ministry The speaker emphasizes the role of individuals as trees of life, delivering God's word and planting seeds in others.
- **Upcoming conference** A conference is scheduled for next week, replacing the usual chapel and class sessions, with a strong encouragement for student attendance.
- **Conference logistics** Details about the conference include multiple sessions, live feed to the basement, and the goal of full attendance.
- **Expectation of divine movement** The speaker expresses a strong belief that God will move powerfully during the conference.
- **Spiritual preparation** Attendees are encouraged to pray about attending the conference, particularly highlighting the kickoff on Friday night.

- **Support for speakers** The speaker requests personal support from the attendees for his session and mentions other speakers and their schedules.
- **Past spiritual experiences** Reference is made to a previous spring conference where a significant spiritual visitation occurred, setting expectations for the upcoming event.
- **Purpose of the meetings** The meetings are not just for the sake of gathering but are intended to constrain the Lord to change lives actively.
