Knowledge Points

1. "Jesus Christ is on the throne. What about the total eclipse? The scripture tells us that signs and wonders were going to

happen before Jesus came. When these things begin to happen, we're to look up for our redemption draws nigh."

2. "Walking in the Spirit is also having the mind of Christ. God wants to be able to have communication going on with you, be able to speak into your spirit, be able to show you things, be able to manifest His will for a certain time."
3. "We don't know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us according to the will of God.
